CLEAR ALIGNER CORRECTION SYSTEM

Clear Aligner:



Clear aligners are used as one of the methods of orthodontic treatment, using a series of removable aligners that create gradual pressure to control tooth movement.

Advantages:

- 01 Pre-visualization before starting the treatment. You can receive and view the final corrected teeth model before starting your treatment.
- 02 Hardly Visible
It's not easy to see that you are using clear aligner.
- 03 Self maintaining- easier oral hygiene maintenance
Since you can remove aligners while eating, drinking, brushing etc.
- 04 Shorter Treatment Time Generally
Compared to conventional braces, Clear aligner treatment period is generally shorter.

Sample Cases That Clevalign Can Correct



A lateral misalignment of the dental arches, in which the upper teeth fall behind the lower teeth

Excessive overlapping of the upper teeth of the lower teeth



A gap between the upper front teeth

When a tooth is dislodged from the dental socket and protrudes down or outwards



A state in which the upper teeth and jaw protrude excessively

A state in which the tooth is not aligned properly in relation to the adjacent and opposite teeth

- 01 Upload four photos in accordance with the instruction on the webpage (www.clevalign.com.my) to get initial assessment for Clevalign aligner suitability. (Optional) or you can visit our panel dentists directly
- 02 Visit our panel dental clinics at your preferred location for more precise diagnosis.
- 03 You will receive a treatment plan together with a 3D corrected model. You can then express your preferences to your dentist and Clevalign will accommodate where possible.
- 04 Wear your aligners for at least 20 hours a day, to achieve the optimum results.
- 05 Visit your dentist, as advised, for progressive evaluation on your corrections.
- 06 After you have completed your correction period, it is advisable to wear a retainer as advised by your dentist to avoid any relapse.
